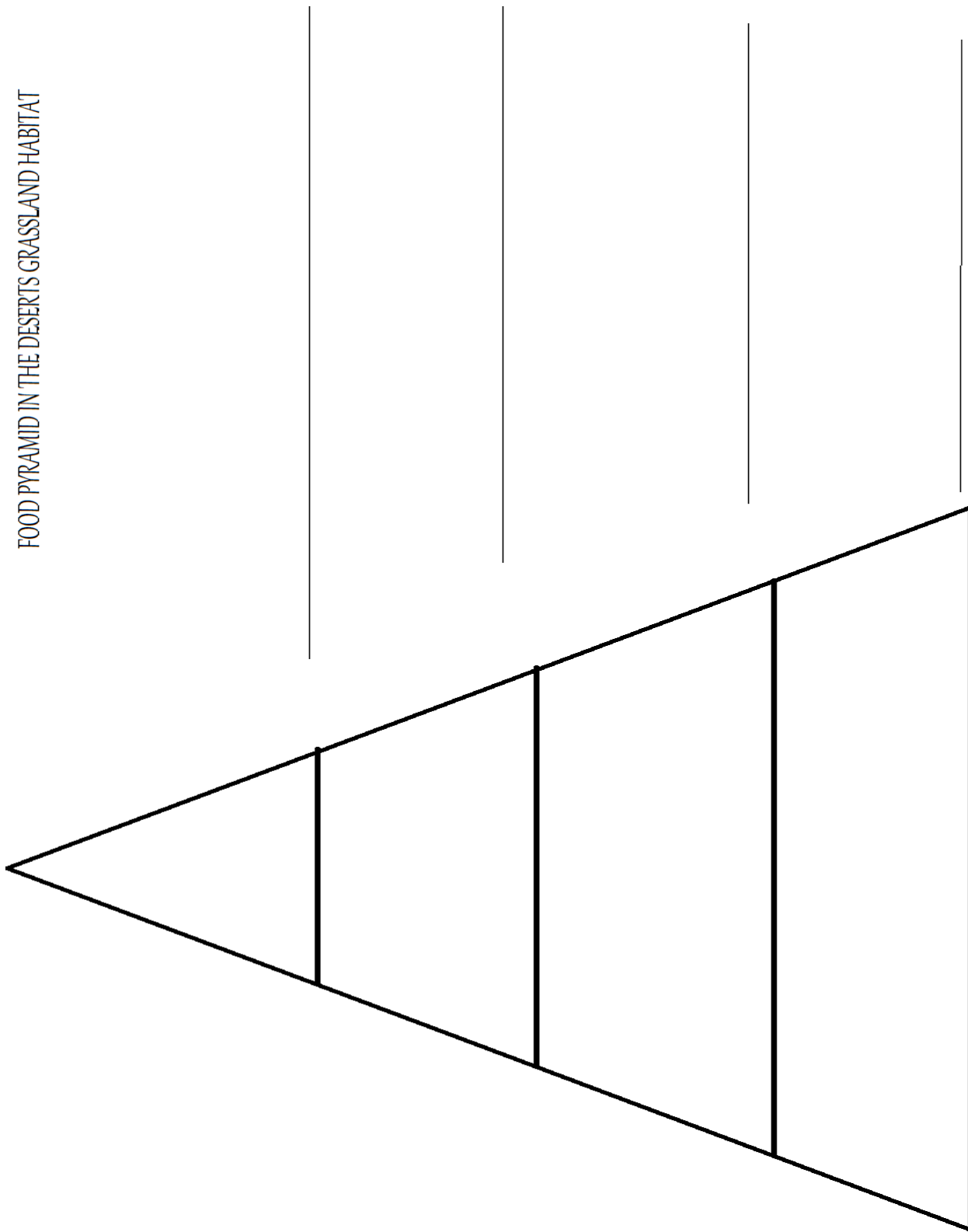
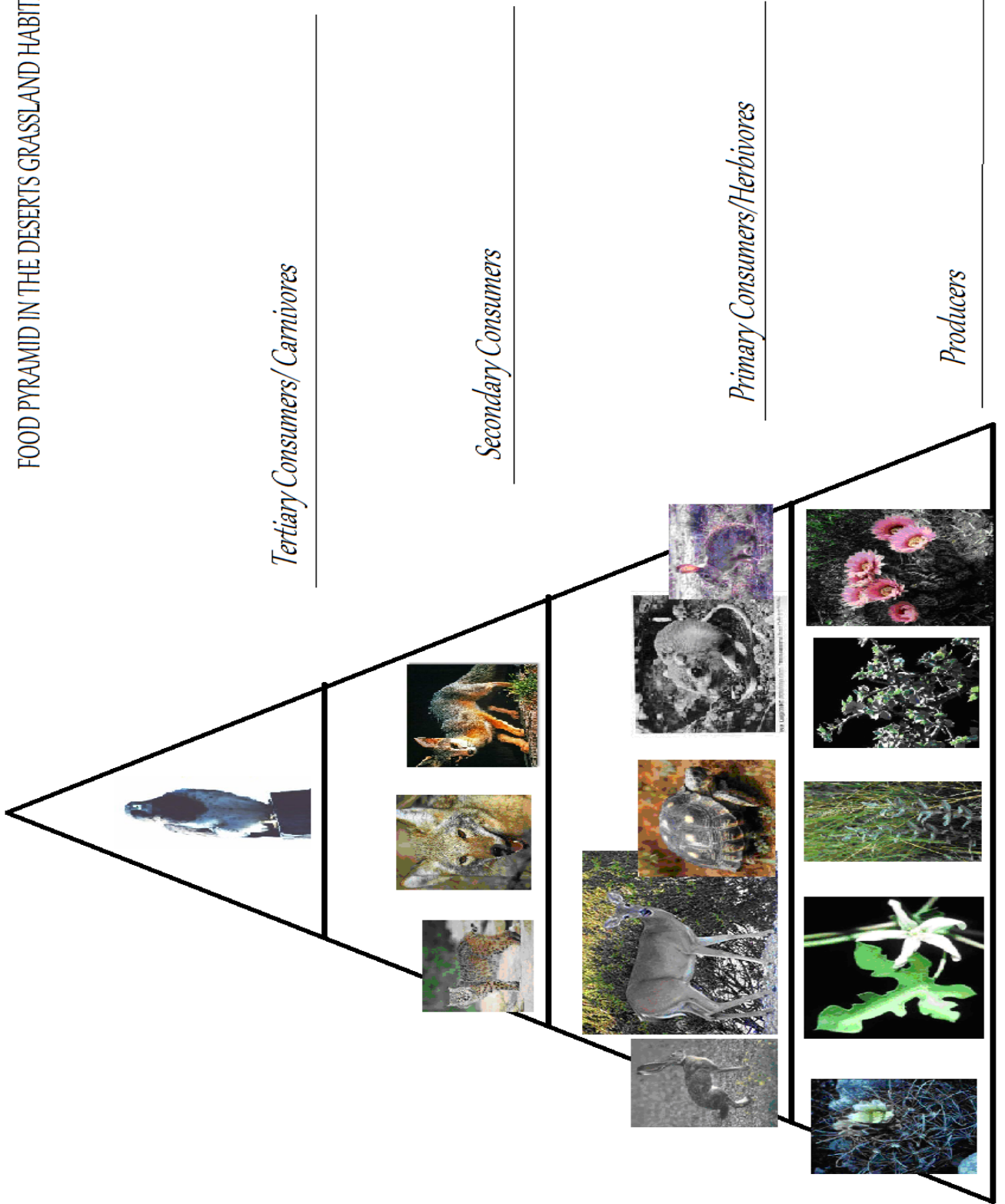

1. Herbivore - animals that eat plants. Example: deer
2. Carnivore - animals that eat meat. Example: lion
3. Omnivore - animals that eat both plants and meat. Example: raccoon
4. Producer - organisms that get their energy/food from the sun. Example: plants
5. Consumer - organisms that get their energy/food from the producers.
Example: herbivores, carnivores, omnivores
6. Primary Consumer - organisms that get their energy/food from the producers. Example: rabbit
7. Secondary Consumer - organisms that get their energy/food from the primary consumers. Example: fox
8. Tertiary Consumer - organisms that get their energy/food from the secondary consumers. Example: lion
9. Food chain – transfer of energy from one organism to another from lower level to higher level.
10. Food web - transfer of energy among various organisms in the habitat.
11. Energy - food that can be obtained from the sun, producers, and secondary consumers.
12. Ecosystem- environment of the organisms
13. Habitat - natural environment where a plant or animal lives.

14. Predator – organism that hunts other organisms for food and other purposes.
